



# how to find your dedicated tree

## Penguin Wood at Botany Bay

Penguin Wood is named after the famous Penguin publishing company which, together with the National Forest Company, has generously funded this woodland creation project. The wood was acquired as part of our 'Tree for All' project which saw one million children plant 12 million trees over five years.

In 2007, around 8,000 trees and shrubs were planted which included field maple, hazel, hawthorn, ash, oak, guelder rose and rowan. In addition, in the central 10 hectare enclosure we have tried a new method of woodland establishment. The land has been deep ploughed, the soil reversed, and both wildflower seeds and 2.4 million tree seeds sown in the autumn of 2007. Penguin Wood is to the west of another Woodland Trust site, Top Wood, located between the village of Linton and Grange Wood, 3 miles south west of Swadlincote and in the heart of the National Forest.

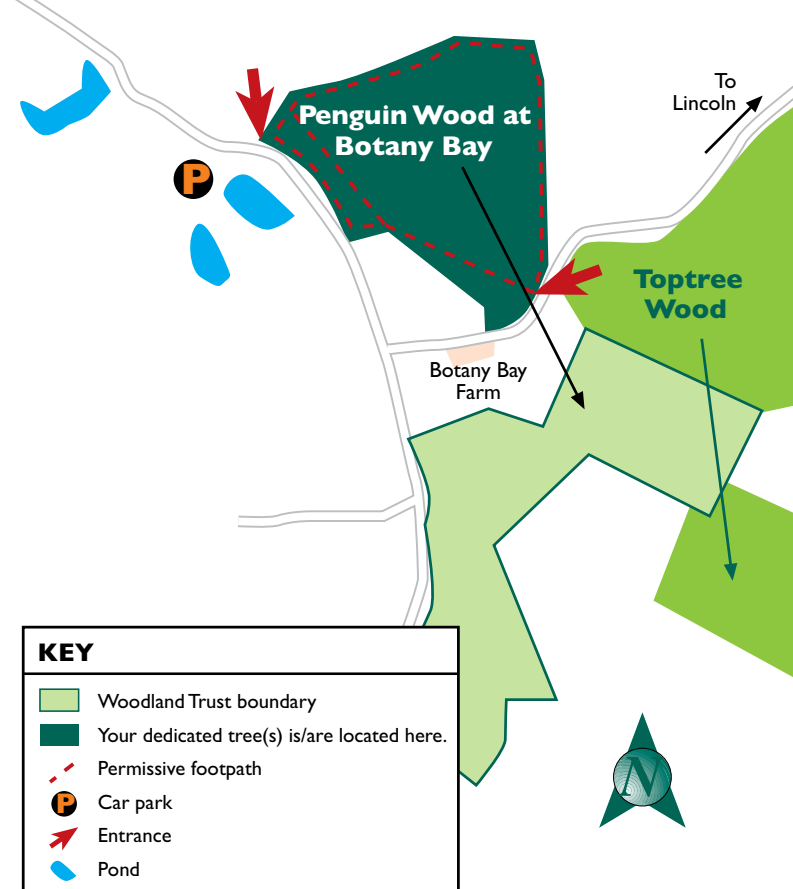
There is a pedestrian entrance in the far north-west corner of the site on the Rosliston Road, 50m south from the entrance to the Beehive Farm fishing lakes car park. There is also an entrance

opposite the lane from Park Farm close to Botany Bay Farm itself. Parking is difficult close to the site and it is recommended that visitors park their car at Beehive Farm car park where there are excellent facilities including a Café, Mini-zoo and toilets. The walk through Beehive Farm to Rosliston Road is very pleasant.
